Our theme: Christmas Camping with Scouts Date: Saturday, November 26, 2005

Parade Start: 6:00 p.m.

Meeting Place: St. Andrew's Plaza @ 5:00 p.m. (Keep in mind that Yonge St. may be blocked off to traffic and you may need to enter off of Orchard Heights)

Pick Up: The end of the parade route is at the Dominion at Henderson Dr. Please be ready for your child's pick up in the Dominion parking lot. The time will depend on our location within the parade. We will have a more accurate pick up time on parade day. What to wear: All sections should wear their neckers on the outside of the coats. Beavers should wear their beaver hats. All others can wear a Santa's hat or festive reindeer antlers... anything Christmassy. Please dress for the weather! Scouters should wear their camping backpacks stuffed with newspaper (unless of course they want to carry a 40 kg. backpack the whole way!) to continue our theme of Christmas camping.

Our float: We will have a truck pulling our 5th Aurora camping trailer, which will have a canoe atop and have Christmas lights decoration. A second vehicle will follow with a small flat trailer, which will include a Christmas campsite scene, complete with a small tent, "campfire", and a decorated Christmas tree. Youth will march along both sides of our floats. Older scouts will rotate carrying banners and our group flags. Other children will be given bags of candy to distribute along the route.
