

Kub Kars 2006



Well. It is that time of year again...Kub Kars ! Since there were few problems with the rules being changed last year we intend to again this year use the basic rules of Kub Kars provided in the kits, with a couple of limitations.. All entries are to be made from the Scouts Canada Kub Kar Kit, **NOT** the pre-cut options available. "Additions" to the cars will **not** be allowed. No part of the completed car, when placed on the race track, is to be in front of the starting gate. Registration numbers must be painted on the top of the kar. Weights are to be placed between the front and back axles and be flush with the bottom of the kar.

PLEASE impress upon your leaders, youth and parents, Kub Kars are to be made by the youth to compete against other youth. There are many youth who have been upset in the past that they have had to compete against cars made by the parents of other cubs and we believe that this is not in the spirit of Scouting or of Kub Kars. Cubs are not expecting, and should not have to compete against anyone other than youth of their same age. Leaders and Parents ARE allowed to help make primary cuts in the wood where power tools and safety are an issue, but design, painting detailing, wheel placement and weights are all to be done by the cubs. They can be assisted but the car is their's and they should be allowed to completely build their cars. Give them a chance. If they have no interest, let the car they build, race as they built it. There is of course exceptions to be made for youth who have difficulties. Leaders and Parents, who would like to make a Kar, please enquire about our Adult Kub Kar Rally. It is great fun for adults and youth

The speed competitions are set up the same this year as in the past. The first races are the Pack Races where the youth compete against members of their own pack. The times and dates for these races are determined by the Kub Kar Coordinators (See list below). From these races 50% of the registered racers will go to the next level, the Area Semi-Finals. Finals are run the afternoon of the Pack races, so be prepared to spend the day. From each Area Semi-Final 50% will proceed to the Area Finals. Once a Kar has been registered, for it to qualify for the additional races and the design competition it cannot go home with the Cub but must stay with the Kub Kar Coordinator.

All Kars are open to the Design competition. Since the Kars are to be made by the youth, there will be **NO** With Help Category. Any Kars wanting to be included in the Design competition must be handed in to the Kub Kar Coordinator at the end of race day. **Any youth Kar deemed by the judges to have had adult participation will lose points in the judging.** The decisions of the judges in this are final. All Kars will be returned to the Leaders at the Area Kub Kar Finals. Leaders please bring boxes to pack the Kars.

The cost for registration is \$3.50. Attached is a spreadsheet that must be completed for registration. The Area co-ordinator will assign registration numbers and race times once the registration information has been received. The coordinators need the registration information as soon as possible to assign race times. The group is expected to pay for every registration number received. Crests will not be ordered until all registrations have been complete.
